Vision Vans

To reach as many children as we can, we take the show on the road with our twin Vision Vans. Each vehicle features a finishing lens lab, a dispensing area and two eye exam lanes. Vision Vans are located in cities, rural outposts, and Indian Reservations to help children who cannot get to stores on wheels without the cash register, traveling to places where they need them most.

Four full-time LensCrafters managers on 18-month sabbaticals and 100 volunteer doctors and associates in each city the vans visit. The Vision Vans have traveled more than 75,000 miles to give the gift of sight to 70,000 children in more than 100 cities.

Hometown Day

One morning each December, LensCrafters stores open early to provide eye exams to pre-selected needy people. On the same day, 100 LensCrafters home office and distribution centers in Cincinnati and throughout the country provide vision screenings for thousands of local public school children.
